

## TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

### TRANSFER STUDENTS MUST FULFILL THESE REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION

- » Minimum GPA of 2.4 for residents (2.8 for nonresidents)
- » Fall applicants must complete all minimum UC admission requirements in English and math by the end of the spring term prior to fall admission. Spring applicants must complete the English and math requirement by the end of the summer prior to admission.
- » Courses that meet WRI 1 and WRI 10 (usually met by completing the UC minimum transfer requirements)
- » A course in mathematics/quantitative reasoning (usually met by completing the UC minimum transfer requirements)
- » Complete 60 UC-transferable semester units the term prior to enrollment (not including summer).
- » Complete all required courses listed on the back of this page for your major with a grade of C or better, unless a higher grade is indicated.

### IMPORTANT

Applicants will be more competitive in the admission process if their academic records show successful attempts at UC-transferable courses, as demonstrated by one or more of the following:

- » Plan in advance. Satisfy major preparatory courses in one attempt with grades of C or better, or a higher-level grade if indicated on the back of this page.
- » Clear all No Pass, D or F grades in any UC-transferable course.

Global Arts Studies Program, B.A.	» At least two UC-transferable courses in Global Arts » GASP 2 or GASP 3
History, B.A.	» At least two UC-transferable courses in History » At least TWO courses from: HIST 10, HIST 11, HIST 16, HIST 17, HIST 30A, HIST 30B or HIST 31
Management and Business Economics, B.S.	» ECON 1 » MATH 11
Philosophy, B.A.	» PHIL 1 » PHIL 4 or PHIL 5
Political Science, B.A.	» POLI 1 or POLI 3 or POLI 5
Psychology, B.A.	» PSY 1 and PSY 10
Public Health, B.A.	» Applicants are admitted based on UC transfer eligibility and encouraged to complete the recommended course(s) prior to admission
Sociology, B.A.	» SOC 1 » At least one of the following courses from the following course ranges: SOC 009, SOC 011-SOC 014, SOC 016-SOC 089 » SOC 10 - If your college does not offer an articulated course for SOC 10, you should complete UC Merced's MATH 5 (see articulation agreement by department) and complete SOC 10 at UC Merced after you transfer.
Spanish, B.A.	» SPAN 4 or SPAN 11

## STRONGLY RECOMMENDED

- » Transfer students are encouraged to complete all of their major preparatory courses and some of the courses needed to satisfy lower-division general education requirements prior to transferring to UC Merced. Completion of the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is recommended for majors within the School of Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts.
